4 MAY, 9.30—4.30

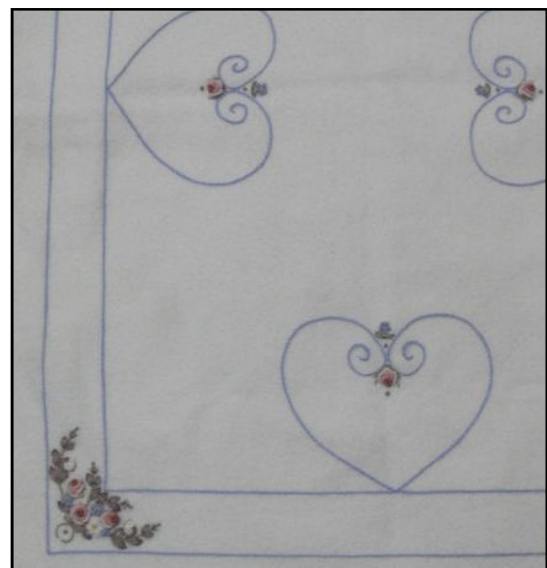
Learn the basics of wool embroidery with Susan and create this beautiful soft pure wool blanket.
