

**Little Blooms:
a Mini Snap Purse**
pattern & embroidery design

The dashed lines around the perimeter indicate the cutting line when it's time for finishing the project into a pouch.

The solid lines around the shape are the seam lines for the purse. These are the lines you will follow when sewing up the pouch.

The dashed lines indicate approximately where the fabric will fold to create the pouch. These are not transferred. They are simply a guide. If you wish, you can transfer a small line within the seam allowance, marking the approximate location of the folds for use during construction.

The large dot surrounded by the dashed line on the lower section indicates where the snap will be sewn. Do not transfer the dashed line.

The design (not including seam allowance - so just the area within the solid lines) should print at 3.75" x 8". Be sure to choose "actual size" or "no scaling" in your printer dialogue box when you print the design.
